MELBOURNE BEACH — The third annual Sea Turtle Celebration, to benefit the renovation of the Sea Turtle Preservation Society headquarters at Ryckman Park, will be held 9 a.m. to 11 p.m. Saturday.

Activities include an arts and crafts show and sale from 9 a.m. until sunset, as well as a benefit auction at 3 p.m., featuring items and services donated by local businesses.

From noon to 4 p.m. will be children's activities including games, contests, face painting and performances by clowns and a magician. At 4 p.m. there will be a performance by The Learning Station, a children's theater group from Nickelodeon, who will deliver a "Just Say No To Drugs" message in song and dance.

Musical entertainment will begin at noon featuring continuous jazz and blues performed by local artists, The Instant Daddy O's, Screaming Iguanas of Love, The Heaters, Chris McCune, Greg Roberts and The Dark, The Trio and The Mammouth Band.

The society will sell hot dogs, hamburgers, barbecue chicken and pork, corn on the cob, ice cream, beer and soft drinks. A combination seafood platter featuring grouper, scallops and clams will be available for \$5.

Ryckman Park is at the west end of Ocean Avenue in Melbourne Beach. Parking and admission are free.
