MELBOURNE — The Brevard Sea Turtle Preservation Society on Sunday will release an endangered green sea turtle nursed back to health after a shark attack. The 2- year-old sea turtle, named Minnie, had one of her flippers bitten off by a shark in an attack off Cocoa Beach in August. Cocoa Beach police rescued her as she washed ashore and took her to the society, where she was treated, said society spokeswoman Lynn St. Louis. The society will release Minnie at noon at the Ambersand Park in Indian River County, 3 1/2 miles south of Sebastian Inlet off State Road A1A.
